From January to May 2018, there was a total fresh supply of 589.1 Mkg, an increase of 5.2%, or 29.1 Mkg over last year. As a result, the total supply was 633.3 Mkg, or 31.2 Mkg higher than last year. Storage stock levels closed at 50.6 Mkg, a noteworthy 10.7 Mkg, or 26.8% higher than last year.

Import levels are still lower than they were last year, with a YTD volume of 68.4 Mkg, a decrease of 1.3 Mkg (1.8%).

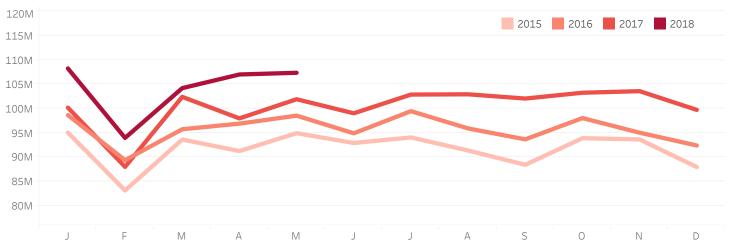

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## Canadian Chicken Production (Mkg) Production de poulet au Canada (Mkg)



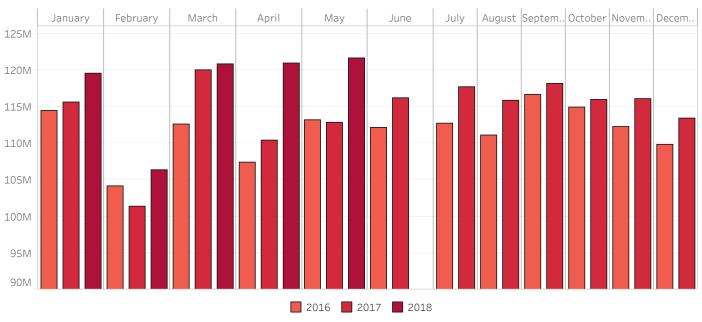

Total YTD chicken production was 520.8 Mkg as of May 2018, up 30.3 Mkg, or 6.2% from last year. While Ontario and British Columbia have been pushing the largest volumes, growth in production is being seen in every province.

Chicken imports as of May 2018 were down in every category except for the Parts Boneless and Further Processed, which respectively saw increase of 5.0 Mkg (14.7%) and 0.2 Mkg (1.2%) over last year. Conversely, notable drops of 4.3 Mkg (22.7%) were seen in Parts Bone-in, and 1.9 Mkg (70.5%) in Other.

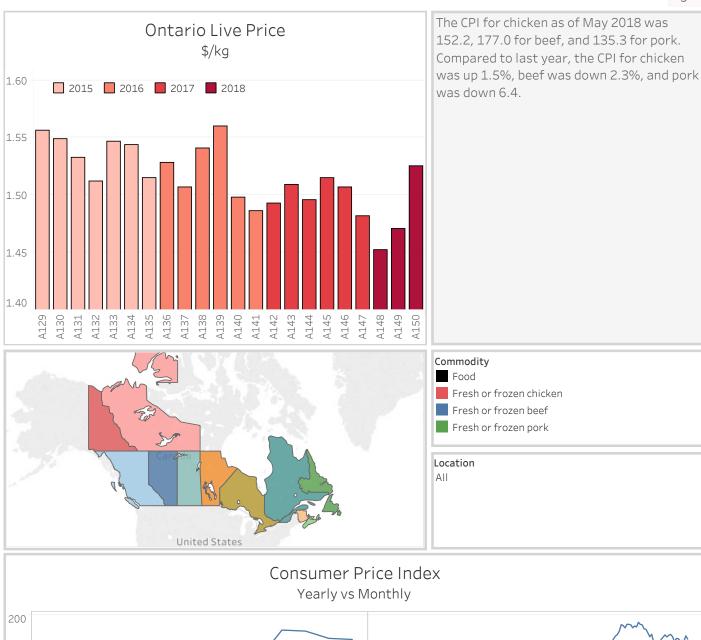

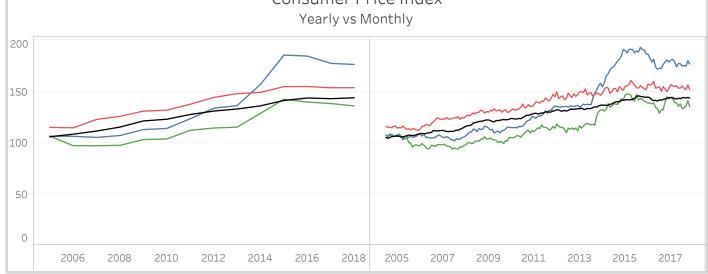

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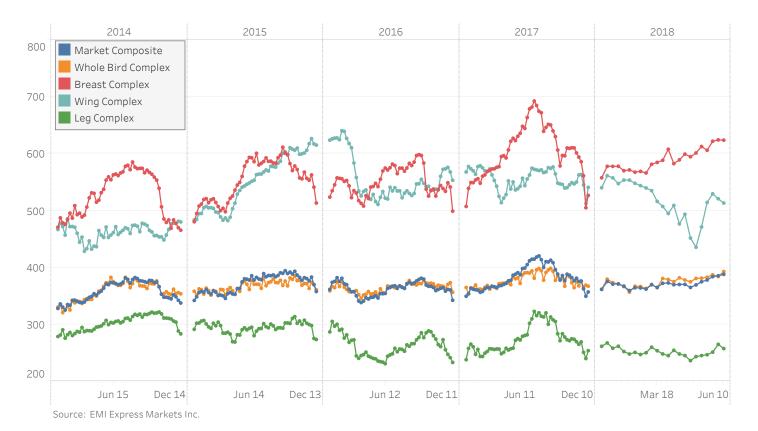

The market composite has steadily increased month-over-month, as the summer got closer. However, compared to last year, the May 2018 market composite of \$3.77/kg was down \$0.06.

The breast complex was still the highest priced complex in May, with a price of \$6.11/kg. Once again, this still marks a decrease of \$0.09 over last year. Prices in the wing complex were down a remarkable \$0.57, while the leg complex was down \$0.14.

Conversely, the whole bird complex was the only complex to experience an increase over last year, at a price of \$3.83/kg, versus \$3.77/kg in May 2017.



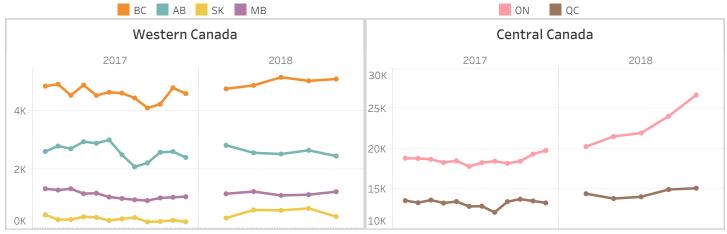

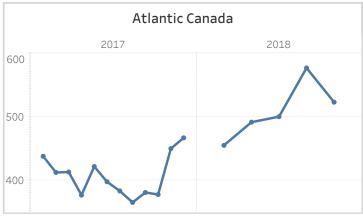

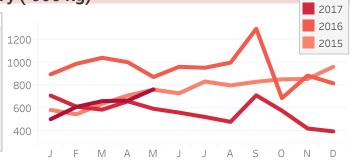
## Total Chicken Storage Stocks ('000 Kg)

#### USDA - Wholesale prices

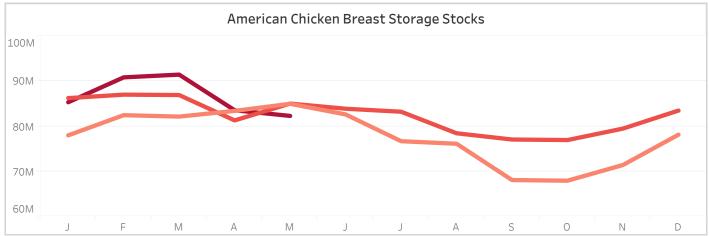
Weighted Average - Cents per pound

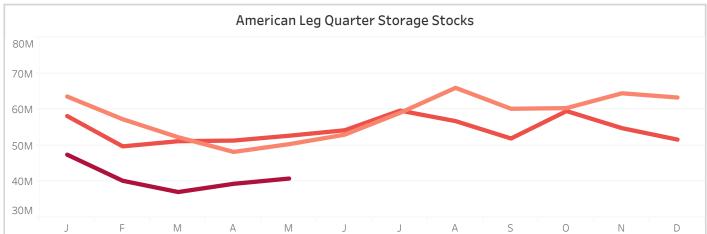


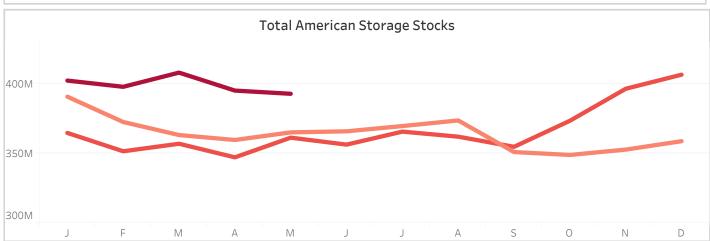
In the United States, the wing still remained king with a wholesale price of \$1.44/lb. The Northeastern state price was lower than that of the Southern state price, at a cost of \$1.40 versus \$1.49.

Boneless breast prices averaged \$1.25/lb in May 2018, regionally the price was higher in the Northeast than it was in the South. The same can be said for boneless thighs, which averaged \$1.14/lb. The Northeast saw a price of \$1.15/lb, while the South saw \$1.13/lb.
